



JOB OPPORTUNITIES – ESTABLISHMENT OF DATA BANK/POOL OF TEAM SUPERVISORS & ENUMERATORS

Bureau of Statistics (BoS), Punjab is the provincial statistical organization mandated to collect, compile, analyze, and disseminate socio-economic data in support of evidence-based planning, policymaking, and development monitoring. It functions as an attached department of the Planning & Development Board, Government of the Punjab. The BoS Punjab frequently receives requests from government departments and international development partners to undertake specialized data collection activities and surveys. To efficiently meet these requirements, BoS Punjab intends to establish a data bank/pool of qualified candidates for the positions of "Team Supervisor" and "Enumerator". This pool will be updated on yearly basis or as and when required.

Key Details:

- **Nature of Engagement:** Daily wage basis (initially for up to 89 days, extendable on satisfactory performance).
- **Mode of Selection:** Shortlisted candidates from the pool will be contacted for interview as and when required for field data collection assignments under various projects during Financial Year 2025-26.
- **Domicile Requirement:** Punjab Province.
- **Remuneration:** As per approved daily wage rates in the PC-I / PC-II / Project document.
- **Work Location:** Anywhere in Punjab.

How to Apply:

Interested and eligible candidates (male/female) are encouraged to apply online through the Punjab Job Portal at www.jobs.punjab.gov.pk. The last date for submission of online applications is **Monday, 06th October, 2025**.

Terms & Conditions:

1. Selection will be made strictly on merit and domicile/district basis. Engagement will be purely temporary on a daily wage basis, with no claim for regularization or permanent employment.
2. The candidates will be called for test/interview only as and when required for specific time bounded activities/survey assignments.
3. The final decision of the Competent Authority shall be binding and will not be challengeable before any court or forum.
4. The Authority reserves the right to terminate the services of any candidate at any stage without assigning any reason.
5. Candidates must bring their original documents along with attested copies of testimonials at the time of interview.
6. Shortlisted candidates will be informed through Email/SMS for interview and training.
7. Selected candidates may be deployed anywhere in Punjab as per project requirements.
8. Candidates who receive training but fail to join field work intentionally will not be entitled to any remuneration for the training session.
9. Any candidate whose services are terminated by the Bureau of Statistics, Punjab, in connection with an assignment during a Financial Year shall be deemed ineligible for engagement in any subsequent assignments / projects within the same Financial Year.
10. Candidates already engaged in an assignment with the BoS Punjab shall not be considered for another assignment until successful completion of their ongoing assignment.
11. Allocation of work will depend upon the nature and duration of the project.
12. Government employees must produce a valid No Objection Certificate (NOC) at the time of interview.
13. Successful candidates will be required to submit a signed acceptance of the offer of appointment, undertaking to complete the assigned task without withdrawal or abandonment until its successful completion.
14. Absence or poor performance shall result in termination of services.
15. The Department shall not be liable to provide health, risk, or life insurance during this temporary engagement.

17. No TA/DA will be admissible for appearing in the interview.
